Advocate Mrs. Amrita Sinha with direction of the Hon'ble High Court to issue offer letter in favour of the petitioner.	The petitioner applied for Auto route permit in the route 237/Auto (Barutpara to Furtura) and the Hon'ble High Court has given mandatory direction to issue offer letter in favour of the petitioner. The Dy. Secretary, Transport Department has also directed to take necessary action in this regard and action taken to be sent to the department.	In compliance of the order of the Hon'ble High Court, the prayer of the petitioner is considered for issuance of offer letter.
2	W.P. No. 29610 (W) of 2014 of Sri Pabitra Chattapadhyay has been received from Ld. Advocate Mrs. Amrita Sinha with direction of the Hon'ble High Court to issue offer letter in favour of the petitioner. Now, the petitioner has submitted contempt notice for non-compliance of the order.	It has been observed that as per mandatory direction of the Hon'ble Court dated 09.12.2014, the petitioner was submitted fresh application vide fees no. PA-108182 dated 16.12.2014 and accordingly permit was issued in favour of the petitioner vide no. PCP-40090 in respect of vehicle no. WB15C 6802 in the same route (198/Auto-Seakhala Bazar to Anhiya). Now, the petitioner has submitted contempt notice for non-compliance of the order dated 09.12.2014.	Heard the petitioner Sri Pabitra Chattapadhyay and he has confessed that contempt notice in c/w non-compliance of the order of the Hon'ble High Court vide W.P. No. 29610(W) of 2014, has been submitted several times by him which was issued by the concerned Advocate, Smt. Amrita Singh though permit has already been issued in compliance of the order of the Hon'ble Court dated 09.12.2014. The petitioner and the concerned Advocate have not only misguided the Hon'ble Court, they are also embarrassing the Govt. Office by making deceptive & unjustified claim which is harmful for performing Govt. activities. Secretary, RTA is directed to forward the matter to the Law Section of Transport Department for taking necessary action.
